Dear Parents of Catholic School Students:

The Saint Alphonse School Health Program is pleased to offer the flu vaccine for all students during the 2016-2017 flu season. Flu vaccine for students has already been ordered but we do not know exactly when we will receive it - once we have it, we will set dates to administer it. We will only be offering the injectable flu vaccine this year. The nasal flu vaccine is no longer available. There is no cost to students for the flu vaccine. Please read, fill out and sign the Consent form in order for your student to receive the flu vaccine at school. The Vaccine Information Sheet will be available along with the Consent form, or you may view it on the CDC website.
