When: Friday, February 3rd, 3:30-5:30

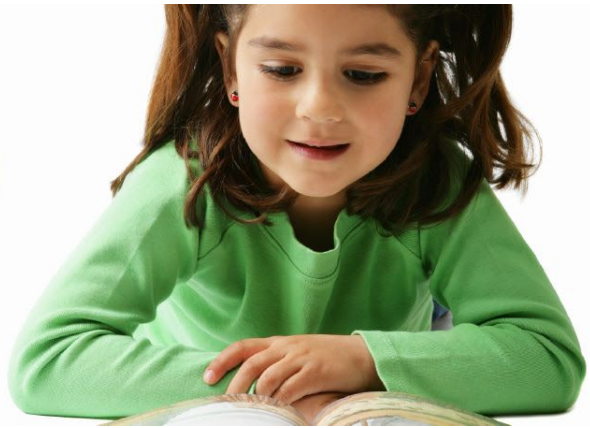
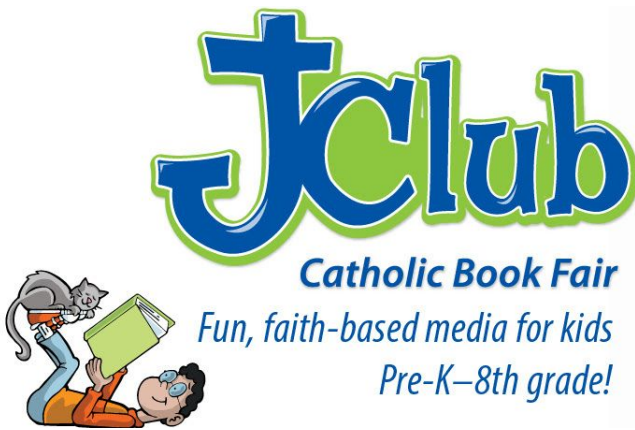
