BK sports physicals

Hello Parents,

It's time again for our annual BK and TVCS sports physicals. I hope you will support our BK Sports Medicine program and receive a high quality physical for your student/athlete(s) performed by our volunteer doctors and nurses. Getting your physical through BK also assures your athlete has their physical on file before the start of the season. It is good through the 2017/18 sports seasons.

BK and TVCS Sports Physicals are scheduled for Sunday, May 7th from 12-4pm at Saint Alphonsus Family Center, 900 N. Liberty St, Suite 204, same place as last year. Athletes must bring their physical form filled out and signed by a parent and the athlete and the \$25 fee (checks made out to BKHS).

Step 1: Register for an Appointment

We have automated the sports physical sign up process to make it more convenient for you and efficient for us. Below is a link to the electronic sheet where you can set an appointment time for your athlete to receive their mandatory annual physical. This is not only a great value at \$25 but it is a fundraiser for our Sports Medicine program and allows us to purchase supplies and equipment for our athletes. 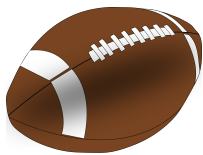
